Note these prices:

DO NOT include any necessary tests or expenses prior to the actual IVF Cycle.

DO NOT include pregnancy tests and pregnancy ultrasounds after IVF cycle.

DO NOT include subsequent frozen embryo transfers.

DO NOT include subsequent yearly cost of embryo storage (\$800)

A \$1,000 non-refundable deposit is due when a donor has been reserved for you. Another \$18,000 deposit **plus** the cost of medication is due prior to the onset of the donor beginning stimulation injections. If ICSI will be needed, an additional \$1,600 will be due.
